## OVERVIEW

**Duration:** 2 full days (6–7 hours/day including breaks)

**Ideal Participants:** Pastors, planters, evangelists, disciple-makers

**Group Size:** 10–30 participants

**Format:** Teaching, discussion, prayer, practice, commissioning

## GOALS

By the end of this 2-day training, each participant will:

- ✓ Understand the **biblical foundations** of church planting
  - ✓ Be able to **start and lead a gathering** anywhere (home, café, WhatsApp, under a tree)
  - ✓ Learn how to **make and multiply disciples** using obedience-based tools
  - ✓ Identify a **target area or people group** to reach
  - ✓ Commit to **starting or multiplying** a gathering within 30 days
  - ✓ Be ready to **train others** using the same material

## MATERIALS NEEDED

- Printed copies of the **Apostolic Church Planting Manual**
  - Journals or notebooks
  - Bibles (physical or phone)
  - Flipchart or whiteboard
  - Markers, pens
  - Optional: projector or speaker for worship/music
  - Water, simple meals, tea breaks

## DAY 1: Vision + Foundation


## Theme: “Jesus Builds His Church — Anywhere, with Anyone”

---

### Session 1 (9:00–10:30 AM)

**Topic:** The Call to Plant — Saying Yes to the Assignment

 Scriptures: Isaiah 6:8, Luke 10:1–3, Acts 13:1–3

 Key Idea: God calls surrendered people to plant spiritual families, not just services.


#### **Activities:**

- Share personal testimonies of call
  - Prayer of surrender (led in local language)
  - Write your “YES” story in 2–3 sentences
- 

### Session 2 (11:00–12:30 PM)

**Topic:** Finding the Person of Peace

 Luke 10, John 4, Acts 16

 Key Idea: Movements begin with people, not plans.

#### **Activities:**

- Role play: talking to strangers, asking spiritual questions
  - Map out your current network (family, neighborhood, work)
  - Prayer walk simulation (or real if possible)
- 

### Lunch Break (12:30–1:30 PM)

---

### Session 3 (1:30–3:00 PM)


**Topic:** Starting Church Anywhere

📖 Matthew 18:20, Acts 2:42–47

🔥 Key Idea: The early church met where life happened — so can we.

**Activities:**

- Group brainstorm: where can we start church? (under trees, WhatsApp, markets, etc.)
  - List obstacles (cultural, financial, spiritual) — discuss how to overcome
  - Choose a real place you could begin a gathering this month
- 

 **Session 4 (3:30–5:00 PM)**

**Topic:** First Gathering Practice

🔥 Key Idea: Simplicity is strength.

**Practice Exercise:**

- In groups of 3–5, simulate a gathering
  - Roles: facilitator, Bible reader, prayer leader, participant
  - Use sample DBS questions + worship + testimony time
  - Give feedback: What felt authentic? What needs help?
- 

 **NIGHT REFLECTION**

**Journal Prompt:** “Lord, where are You calling me to plant?”

**Prayer Focus:** A heart of surrender and boldness

**Optional Assignment:** Write a vision prayer for your city/village/neighborhood

## **DAY 2: Tools + Multiplication**


## Theme: “Every Disciple a Planter, Every Gathering a Seed”

---

### Session 5 (9:00–10:30 AM)

**Topic:** Obedience-Based Discipleship

 Matthew 28:18–20, John 14:15


 Key Idea: We don't teach for knowledge — we disciple for obedience.


**Activities:**

- Practice using the DBS method in pairs (new passage)
  - Share one personal act of obedience you've taken recently
  - Discuss: How do we lovingly hold each other accountable?
- 

### Session 6 (11:00–12:30 PM)

**Topic:** Multiplication through Releasing Others

 2 Timothy 2:2, Luke 9 & 10

 Key Idea: Release > control. Leaders are seed-planters, not platform-builders.

**Activities:**

- Identify 2 people you can disciple or mentor
  - Write a plan to train someone else using this material
  - Practice commissioning someone (blessing, prayer, encouragement)
- 

### Lunch Break (12:30–1:30 PM)

---

### Session 7 (1:30–3:00 PM)


**Topic:** Moving in Prayer and Power

📖 Mark 16:17–18, Acts 1:8, James 5:16

🔥 Key Idea: The Kingdom of God is not in words, but in power.

**Activities:**

- Share testimonies of healing, deliverance, answered prayer
  - Pray for the sick in the room
  - Invite Holy Spirit to give vision and boldness
  - Teach how to lead Spirit-led gatherings (not controlled by script)
- 

 **Session 8 (3:30–5:00 PM)**

**Topic:** Commissioning + Next Steps

🔥 Key Idea: We don't just finish the training — we launch the mission.

**Activities:**

- Have each person share:
  - Where they will plant
  - Who they will disciple
  - When they will begin
- Lay hands on each participant (or anoint with oil)
- Speak words of prophetic encouragement over the group

*“We send you not as leaders of buildings, but as carriers of the Kingdom.  
Go. Plant. Disciple. Multiply. God is with you.”*
