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Workshop Purpose:

To equip Christian entrepreneurs to:

- ✓ Understand their work as worship
 - ✓ Operate in Kingdom values, not worldly systems
 - ✓ Start and grow businesses that make disciples
 - ✓ Partner with God to bring transformation in the marketplace
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Format Options:

- **1-Day Workshop** (5 sessions + breaks)
 - **2-Day Intensive** (deeper activation + testimonies)
 - **Modular delivery** (one session per week over 5 weeks)
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Materials Needed:

- Bible for each participant
 - Whiteboard or paper/chart
 - Journals or printed worksheets
 - Local testimonies if available
 - Water/snacks if offering hospitality
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SESSION OUTLINE:

Session n	Focus Area	Time (1-Day Format)
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1	You Are Called	60 min
2	Kingdom vs. World Systems	60 min
3	Purpose-Driven Planning	60 min
4	Integrity, Risk & Warfare	60 min
5	Multiplication & Impact	60 min

SESSION 1: You Are Called

 **Theme:** *Your business is your ministry.*

 **Read:** Colossians 3:23–24

“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart... it is the Lord Christ you are serving.”

Objectives:

- Help participants see their work as sacred
 - Break the lie that “real ministry” only happens in church
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Discussion Starters:

- What do people think about Christians doing business?
 - What lies have you believed about your work?
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Activity: Calling Clarity Worksheet

Prompt: What problem does your business solve?
Why does that matter to God?

✓ Ask each participant to write:

“God has called me to glorify Him through _____.”

Prayer Activation:

Lay hands on one another and say:

“Your business is holy. Your calling is valid. You are sent to the marketplace.”

SESSION 2: Kingdom vs. World Systems

 **Theme: *We do business differently.***

 Read: Matthew 6:33 | Romans 12:2

Teach: Comparison Grid

World System	Kingdom Culture
Self-promotion	God-exaltation
Fear-driven decisions	Faith-filled obedience
Compromise to win	Integrity under pressure
Competition	Collaboration
Ownership	Stewardship

Small Group Questions:

- Which worldly mindset have you struggled with?
 - What would it look like to run your business “Kingdom-first”?
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Activation:

Have each person write a **Kingdom Business Covenant**:

“I commit to run my business in a way that honors God in character, decisions, and relationships.”

SESSION 3: Purpose-Driven Planning

 **Theme:** *God gives vision — we steward it in obedience.*

 Read: Habakkuk 2:2 | Proverbs 16:3

Exercise: Vision Canvas

Participants fill out:

1. **Mission** – Why do I exist?
 2. **People** – Who do I serve?
 3. **Product/Service** – What am I offering?
 4. **Kingdom Impact** – How will lives be changed?
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Group Share:

Invite 2–3 to share their vision canvas and receive feedback/prayer.

Prayer Focus:

Ask God for divine strategy, clarity, and timing. Anoint hands symbolically.

SESSION 4: Integrity, Risk & Spiritual Warfare

 **Theme:** *Business is a battlefield — fight with faith and truth.*

 Read: Ephesians 6:10–18 | Proverbs 11:1

Teach:

3 Battlegrounds Every Kingdom Entrepreneur Faces:

1. **Temptation** – to lie, bribe, or cut corners
 2. **Fear** – failure, loss, rejection
 3. **Warfare** – opposition from spiritual powers
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Discussion:

- Share a time you were tempted in business. What did you do?
 - Where are you under pressure right now?
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Prayer Focus:

- Break fear and greed

- Declare purity and boldness
 - Intercede for regional strongholds in the business sector
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SESSION 5: Multiplication & Impact

 **Theme:** *God's goal is not just profit — it's transformation.*

 Read: Matthew 28:19 | Luke 16:10

Testimonies (if available):

- Invite a local businessperson to share how their faith impacts their business
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Challenge Questions:

- How will you disciple in your business?
 - Who can you train or employ as part of your mission?
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Commissioning Commitment:

Have each person write:

“I will multiply what God gives me by investing in people, telling the gospel, and building for the Kingdom.”

Final Commissioning:

Lay hands and pray over each person:

“You are a Kingdom entrepreneur. You are anointed for business and breakthrough. Go build with Heaven’s strategy and reproduce what God has placed in your hands.”
