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ROLE OF A PRAYER COORDINATOR

A **Prayer Coordinator** is not just a prayer warrior — they are a *spiritual activator*, charged with:

- Calling people to **repentance and revival**
 - Sustaining ongoing **intercession and fasting**
 - Equipping others to pray and lead
 - Listening to the **Holy Spirit for prophetic direction**
 - Creating a structure that is **local and multiplying**
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5 Core Responsibilities

1. Set the Spiritual Temperature

- Live as a personal model of prayer, holiness, and hunger.
- Protect the atmosphere from spiritual apathy.

2. Mobilize Intercessors & Leaders

- Identify, invite, and train others to pray.
- Don't carry it alone — multiply prayer leaders in zones, churches, or villages.

3. Equip Others to Pray Effectively

- Teach simple, reproducible prayer formats.
- Encourage Spirit-led, Scripture-rooted intercession.

4. Focus Prayer on Strategic Targets

- Lead prayer for regional needs: government, unreached villages, youth, schools, families.
- Coordinate special focuses (healing, deliverance, fasting, repentance).

5. Listen and Report What God Is Saying

- Gather dreams, visions, insights from prayer.
 - Share summaries with regional leaders, pastors, or apostolic teams.
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TRAINING TOOLS & TEMPLATES

1. The Prayer Circle Model

Use this 4-part rhythm in every prayer meeting:

1. **Worship** – 5–10 minutes (sing, Scripture, thanksgiving)
 2. **Word-Based Prayer** – Read a verse, then pray from it
 3. **Warfare** – Bind darkness, declare victory
 4. **Watchfulness** – Listen to the Holy Spirit & record what He says
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2. Weekly Prayer Schedule (Example)

Day	Focus	Scripture
Monday	Personal revival	Psalms 51, Romans 12
Tuesday	Youth and students	1 Timothy 4:12
Wednesday	Families & marriages	Joshua 24:15
Thursday	Churches & discipleship	Matthew 28:19–20
Friday	Government & justice	1 Timothy 2:1–4
Saturday	The lost & unreached	Romans 10:14–15
Sunday	Worship and thanksgiving	Psalms 100

3. Prayer Chain Formats

Choose the best method for your people:

- 🕒 *Hourly Watch*: Each person prays for 1 hour per day
 - ➡️ 📱 *WhatsApp Chain*: Daily prayer prompts and reports
 - 🧑 *Weekly Gathering*: In-person, outdoors, or home-based
 - 🏠 *Prayer in Homes*: Assign families to pray once a week
 - 🙌 *All-Night Watch*: Monthly citywide or regional meeting
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4. Monthly Coordinator Checklist

- ✓ Have I spent personal time in fasting and prayer this week?
 - ✓ Have I contacted my zone/intercessor team this week?
 - ✓ Have I gathered or shared prayer testimonies?
 - ✓ Have I distributed new prayer points or Scriptures?
 - ✓ Are any of my leaders discouraged, sick, or in need?
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Leading Spiritual Warfare in Prayer

As a coordinator, teach how to:

- Break **demonic strongholds** (fear, division, sexual immorality, corruption)
- Declare **Scripture out loud** with boldness
- Use **Jesus' name** and the **authority of the blood**
- Cover gatherings and leaders in prayer **before and after** every event
- Be discerning about **spiritual resistance and regional oppression**

✓ Train teams using **Ephesians 6, 2 Corinthians 10, Psalm 91**

Unreached area	Kanyenya, Kiryandongo	No gospel witness
School	Miringa Secondary	Student revival
Family	The Ouko family	Addiction, reconciliation
Government	Ward 6 District Leaders	Justice, wisdom, protection
Pastor/Leader	Pastor Mary (Zone 2)	Strength and provision

✓ Update monthly. Assign intercessors.

Coaching & Multiplication Plan

Train 2–3 others to:

- Lead prayer groups
- Mobilize prayer in their village
- Collect and share prayer needs + breakthroughs

✓ Use the “*I do, we do, you do*” model:

1. You watch me lead.
2. We lead together.
3. You lead. I coach.

4. You train someone else.
