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Workshop Purpose

To help young believers understand:

- ✓ They are **called by God**, not just trying to survive
 - ✓ Business is a **Kingdom assignment**, not just a hustle
 - ✓ They can **build with purpose, power, and purity**
 - ✓ Every business is a **disciple-making opportunity**
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Workshop Format

- 1-day format (5 hours + lunch + prayer)
 - Split into 5 sessions (each ~50–60 minutes)
 - Includes stories, group work, journaling, and prayer
 - Optional “Business Idea Pitch Circle” at the end

SESSION 1: I Am Sent

Theme: *You are a Kingdom builder, not just a business owner.*

📖 Read: **Colossians 3:23–24**

Ask: Who are you really working for?

💡 Talk Starter:

- What job or business idea do you dream about?
 - Do you think God cares about that?
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🧠 Teach:

You don't need a pulpit — your business is your mission field.
You're not too young. God calls youth into big things.

✅ Share the story of Joseph, David, or Lydia (Acts 16)

✍️ Identity Declaration (Write & Share):

"God has called me to build His Kingdom through _____."

Examples: farming, design, selling food, fixing bikes, coding, braiding, tutoring...



SESSION 2: Do It God's Way

Theme: *There's a difference between hustle and holy.*

📖 Read: **Matthew 6:33 | Romans 12:2**

🤔 Teach: Hustle vs. Kingdom Table

Hustle Mode

Get rich fast

Kingdom Way

Steward what I'm given

Do anything to win	Walk in truth & trust
Compare and compete	Collaborate & celebrate
Work for self	Work for the Lord

Activity: “Which one are you tempted by?”

Have youth circle their most common “hustle trap”
Then write a short prayer:

“Lord, help me trust You instead of _____.”

SESSION 3: Dream Big, Build Slow

Theme: *You need vision more than money.*

 Read: **Habakkuk 2:2** – “Write the vision...”

- **Luke 16:10** – “Be faithful with little”
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Vision Map (Worksheet)

Write 1 sentence for each:

1. My business idea is...
2. It helps people by...
3. My long-term dream is...
4. I want my work to honor God by...

 Pair-share and pray over each other’s vision



SESSION 4: Walk Clean, Stand Strong

Theme: *Temptation is real. Your integrity matters more than income.*

 Read: **Proverbs 11:1** – “God hates dishonest scales”

- **1 Timothy 4:12** – “Set an example...”
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Group Talk:

- What temptations face young entrepreneurs?
(e.g. stealing data, lying, sexual offers, fraud)
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Skit or Role Play:

Act out 2 common pressure situations:

1. Offered a bribe
2. A client flirts to get free service

Discuss: “How would Jesus want me to respond?”

 Pray for purity, boldness, and wisdom



SESSION 5: Build Others, Not Just Profit

Theme: *Kingdom entrepreneurs multiply disciples, not just money.*

 Read: **Matthew 28:19** – “Make disciples...”

- **Acts 18** – Paul made tents + disciplined leaders
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 Ask:

- How could your business help someone meet Jesus?
 - Who can you teach what you've learned today?
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 Challenge:

- Write 1 name: Who will you train or encourage in the next 30 days?

 Lay hands, pray, and commission them
